My name is Kevan Baker, age thirty two. I live at 3030 Peachtree, apartment number one telephone number 855-1600, extension forty five. I am employed at McKenzie Volkswagon. On Friday, February 4, 1983 on or about 8:15PM, I pulled into the Sigmore Shamrock station located at 2602 South Padre Island Drive to get gas. I got out of my car and put the nozzle into my tank. Before I could start to pump gas I heard this bang inside the store. I looked up and I seen this man pulling this lady from behind the counter by the hair. This man was a Hispanic male, five feet eight inches tall, one hundred and seventy pounds, dark hair, about twenty four years old, looked like he had a mustache. He had on what looked like a flannel shirt with some red in it. The lady was a Hispanic female. She appeared to be the clerk. When I seen him pulling her by the hair I first thought they were playing, then I noticed he was really pulling her. She was bent over and he was trying to force her into the back room. When I noticed they were not playing I started walking towards the building. I took maybe four or five steps towards the building and this man must have seen me, because he threw the lady down never getting her to the back room. He came out the door face to face with me. He told me don't mess with me I got a gun, and ran off behind the station. About that time a man drove in, I told him to call the police and he went right over to the telephone to call and I approached the lady coming out the front door. She had blood all over her. She fell into the building and I helped her on down to the ground. All she said was, "Help me, help me." I went on into the building and went behind the counter to get some paper towels. I noticed there was money all over the floor. By the time I got back out the police was already there. I did not even have time to use the paper towels. While I was still there about fifteen to twenty minutes later, a police car drove up and they had this man I just described in this statement with them. They asked me if I could identify him. They stood him out beside the patrol car and I positively identified him as the same man I seen fighting with the lady inside the Shamrock at about 8:15PM on February 4, 1983; however, now he did not have on a shirt. I came to the police station and spoke with Sergeant Garrett, and gave him this statement and while talking with Sergeant Garrett he told me the man I identified was named Carlos DaLuna. This statement is true and correct and given to Sergeant Garrett of my own free will. End
