

On February 4, 1983 I was at home when I received a call from my father, sometime between 8:00-8:30 p.m., who lives down the street from me at 4906 Easter. He wanted me to go over and pick up some tamales. My older son, Joe and I then walked to his house. I noticed then that there were quite a few police units in the area, driving up and down the neighborhood. I got to my father's house and I stayed there about five to ten minutes. Afterwards I returned home; I again noticed the police units in the area, one was even parked around the corner from my house. I came into the house and I mentioned to my husband, Joe that there were several police units around the neighborhood. He told me to stay inside and to lock the doors. About two minutes later I started back outside; I was going to go ask the policeman who was parked around the corner what was going on. When I went outside I saw that the police unit was gone. I then noticed that there was a man hiding under my truck which was parked in front of our house. The front porch light was turned on so I was able to distinguish that it was a man, I saw his lower torso laying underneath the truck, he had on light colored tennis shoes, light colored pants and possibly a white shirt. He appeared to be slender build, about 5'4 to 5'6. The light was shining from the porch onto the puddle of water which collected under the truck too, this was why I thought it unusual that someone would lay in a puddle of water under my truck. I immediately yelled to my husband that there was a man hiding under our truck. At this same time I saw the man edge out slowly from underneath the truck and then head east on Nemece toward Franklin St. My husband came out told me to get our son Jim into the house. Joe then returned inside, put on his blue jeans and got his pistol and then went back outside. He searched the area around the truck and alongside our fence line around the corner but saw no one and then he returned into the house. This statement is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
