Re: Summary of Efrain HERNANDEZ death record at office of the County Clerk of Nueces County

Efrain HERNANDEZ, DOB: 11/16/57 died on 05/18-19/79 – the precise time of death was late pm on the 18th or the early morning of the 19th. The location of death was Diaz Park (as in open space) at intersection of North Matiana Ortiz Boulevard and West Ligustrum in Robstown, Nueces County.

Father is recorded as Carlos HERNANDEZ and mother as Fidela HERNANDEZ.

Cause of death was traumatic head injury and aspiration of blood. A description of how the injury occurred was that the deceased was beaten and stabbed with a bottle. The cause of death was ruled a homicide.

Other significant causes contributing to death but not directly related to the terminal disease condition was a blood alcohol level of 0.255%.

Autopsy took place 05/20/79 and burial followed on 05/22/79 at Rose Hill Cemetery in Corpus Christi.

A search of the Robstown Record-Star newspaper, a weekly publication, from 05/24/79 to 11/22/79 produced 1 article in the 05/24/79 edition. In that article Captain Secundino TAMEZ of the Robstown PD admitted that there were very few leads. The Robstown PD claim that all offense reports, even homicides, are destroyed after 10 years.

William's email says: I've a few more checks to run - the handwritten felony case log books at the district clerk's office for 1979 cases and previous - but i get the sense that nobody was arrested for this crime. i'll see if capt Tamez is still with the Robstown PD. william
