INVESTIGATION MEMORANDUM

RE: CARLOS DELUNA

On the above date I contacted **SHIRLEY A. CURRIE (DOB 1/9/38)**, at her place of business, [material removed]. She has been employed with this company for the past 16 years as the office manager. [Material removed] Ms. Currie was employed at the 7-11 convenience store on Staples and Mary as the night manger in late 70's. I identified myself, stated who I represented and the purpose of my visit to which she understood.

Ms. Currie has 4 daughters and 1 son—one of her sons is dead. **Cindy Stevens**, the daughter we have been looking for, is a massage therapist in San Antonio[.] [Material removed]

In 1982/83 Ms. Currie was living in San Antonio, Texas and was diagnosed with diabetes. She was also being treated for depression. She stated, "The shock treatments for my depression took away some of my memory. However, bits and pieces have come back". I provided Ms. Currie with a

copy of her testimony in the Garza trial and after reading it she still had difficulty in remembering most of her testimony. She did provide me with the following information in re the "Players".

- Mario Martinez and Ms. Currie had a *on and off* relationship for approximately a year in the late 70's or early 80's. She stated, "We never lived together but when Mario needed something he would always come around. I have a mother complex and I always took in strays—I am a care giver. In addition I guess I always dated younger men. I have now been with the same man, 11 years younger than me for 22 years".
- She remembers that Mario and David were always in trouble but when I asked her about details she couldn't remember. She does recall them both being heavy drinkers and always looking out for the police. They lived by South Bluff Park.
- Ms. Currie has not been in contact with Mario or David in the past 20 years and does not know how to contact them. Several years ago their sister (did not know her name) was working at Sam's Club on Greenwood.
- According to Ms. Currie she remembers Carlos Hernandez from either him working at the 7-11 or he just hung out there. She stated, "I knew Carlos Hernandez from the store-I may have even hired him. Of the kids in the neighborhood he seemed to be the nicer of the kids-- never saw him in a violent situation—he was not a bad kid. After I left the 7-11 in 81/82 I never saw him again".
- As she recalls Carlos Hernandez never went to her home--only Mario.

When I showed Ms. Currie the side by side photographs of Carlos Hernandez and Carlos DeLuna she identified the younger photograph of Carlos DeLuna as being Carlos Hernandez

She stated, "As a younger man—yes"
