

JSL notes of Peso summary of his interview with Gilbert Limon 8/11/04

Gilbert Limon did not know C. Hernandez pre-Dina.

1989- just prior to Dina Ybanez being stabbed, Gilbert was dating Dina.

C. Hernandez lived in Dina Ybanez's garage and babysat her kids.

When Limon was with Dina, she never did drugs. She never did drugs when knew it. Recently, she got in with another druggie. He said she is truthful.

When Limon gets out—he told her; I'll be back in 10 years but you move on with your life. Limon now wants to see his children and be responsible.

Dina would bring in strays. Anyone that was down and out; people take advantage.

Gilbert was dating her and knew that C. Hernandez lived in the garage.

Just before stabbing, G.L. says C. Hernandez pulls out a knife and slashed his own chest—like a rooster getting ready to fight. G.L. (21 years old) says: Don't go doing that because I'll do it back. (C. Hernandez goes after women; chicken with men)

Dina stabbed- visits her in hospital. G.L. moves Dina out into different house.

Before he does this, finds sheaf of papers from C. Hernandez in garage – a murder of some girl; probably Dahlia. No names.

C. Hernandez keeps coming around but G.L. scares him away and C. Hernandez doesn't do anything.

They move.

G.L. is put in jail 5 years later for aggravated assault on an officer.

He is about to get out. He says here about DeLuna.

G.L. says he was in prison with Manuel DeLuna who said my brother took the rap for someone else. G.L. put it together.

Buck knife—yep those are the type of knife. Sharpening; opening

G.L.'s view of C. Hernandez preyed on women.

G.L.—smart; inquisitive; figured out; not in touch with Dina for long time
