Ms. Maria Martinez is the matriarch of the “Green Eyed Martinez’s” family who resided on Carrizo Street during late 70’s and 80’s. Children of Maria Martinez: Roberto Ramirez, Laredo, TX, Mario Martinez, OK, Eric M. Garza, James Martinez, Eleno Martinez, CC, TX, David Martinez, Louisville, KY, Juanita Grando, CC, TX, Sylvia Gomez, CC, TX, Rose Martinez Lopez, CC, TX, Gloria Uribe, San Antonio, TX, Linda Martinez, Dallas, TX, Reba Martinez, CC, TX, and Bertha Martinez Garcia, deceased at age 33.

I located Maria through her daughter Reba Martinez who resides at [material removed]. Reba has no memory of Carlos Hernandez but referred to her mother Maria Martinez as a good person to talk to regarding the Martinez family’s time living on Carrizo Street.

Maria Martinez is a disabled, elderly, frail woman who, among other disabilities, has a heart condition that flairs up with stress. Maria remembers Carrizo Street, Carlos Hernandez and his family in the late 70’s and early 80’s. Maria did not talk to or associate with Carlos Hernandez, Fidela or any other family members. While living on Carrizo Street Maria heard, she does not know from who, that Carlos Hernandez killed a lady in a van.

Maria described Carlos Hernandez and a “mean man”. While living on Carrizo

Street in the early 80's Carlos Hernandez tried to rape Maria's daughter Bertha. Bertha told Maria she was at the Hernandez house to visit with Carlos Hernandez's sister Paula when Carlos Hernandez forced her behind the Hernandez house where Carlos Hernandez tried to rape her. Bertha managed to kick Carlos Hernandez, freed herself and ran home. The attempted rape was not reported to the police.

Of Maria's children Mario was close to Carlos Hernandez. They hung out together. [material removed]
