On 02-04-83, at approximately 8:09 p.m., I heard an armed robbery alert go out over the radio, taking place at the Sigmor gas station located at 2602 South Padre Island Drive. At this time, I was at Gollihar & Ayers. Upon arrival at the scene, I observed Unit #143, Sgt. Steve Fowler #149, on his knees attending the clerk, who was lying on her side in a pool of blood at the entrance of the store. Sgt. Fowler then advised me to gather all the witnesses at the scene and secure them. I then contacted Witness #1, Kevin Baker, who advised me that, as he was getting ready to pump gas into his car, he saw the clerk inside the store struggling with a Hispanic male, approximately 5'7" to 5'9", wearing a light colored shirt and dark pants.

The witness, Mr. Baker, advised me that he then observed the subject attempt to carry the clerk into the back room of the store. Mr. Baker advised me that he then started to walk into the store to help the clerk. As he neared the door, Mr. Baker advised that the subject released the girl and walked out of the store saying, "I got a gun, get back." Mr. Baker advised that the clerk then slumped on him, and he laid her on the floor, just outside the door of the store. Mr. Baker advised me that the subject then ran east from the store. After I contacted Mr. Baker, I contacted Witness #2, George Aguirre, who advised me that at approximately 8:00 p.m., while he was pumping gas into his van at the gas station, he observed a Hispanic male, approximately 5'7" to 5'9", wearing a white shirt (long-sleeve), untucked, and dark pants, standing on the east side of the store. Mr. Aguirre then advised me that he observed the subject pull out a pocket knife type of knife and unfold it and stick it in his pants. Mr. Aguirre then advised that the subject approached him and asked for a ride to the Casino. Mr. Aguirre was at the east pump section of the gas station at the time. After Mr. Aguirre advised the subject he could not give him a ride, the subject walked away. Mr. Aguirre advised me that he then walked into the store and advised the clerk that the subject, who was standing outside of the store, had a knife. Mr. Aguirre advised me that, as he was walking out of the store, the subject entered the store. Mr. Aguirre advised that he saw the subject standing by the

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cooler inside the store as he was getting ready to leave the gas station. I then contacted Witnesses #3 and #4, who were together in their car driving into the Phase III parking lot at 2632 South Padre Island Drive, just east of the Sigmor gas station, and they both advised me that they observed a Hispanic male, approximately 5'7" to 5'9", dark hair, wearing a white long-sleeve shirt untucked and unbuttoned, running across the Phase III parking lot, eastbound, toward the rear of the Lebowitz Furniture Store located at 2650 South Padre Island Drive. Both witnesses, Mr. and Mrs. John Arsuaga, stated that the subject was not running very fast and seemed to stop and look at them momentarily as he ran. I was then advised by Witness #2, Mr. Aguirre, that the subject had been drinking a can of beer as he stood at the east side of the store. Sgt. Fowler and myself then found two empty cans of Miller Lite beer at the side/rear portion of the store on the grass. We then had I. D. Unit #503, Infante, photograph the cans and process for prints. Approximately 35 minutes later, I learned a suspect had been apprehended and brought back to the scene to be identified by some of the witnesses. Witness #1, Kevin Baker, and Witness #2, George Aguirre, were able to positively identify the subject, which had been apprehended, as the same subject who they observed at the gas station.
