MCI INDEX

As directed by Sgt. O. Escobedo #388, C.I.D., this report is being submitted to relate my observations of suspect #1's conduct before and after he was arrested on 2-4-83.

Suspect #1 was first observed by me after I heard another officer yell that a subject was hiding under a pick up truck on 4900 Franklin. After I heard this, I assumed a prone position on the street at which time I observed suspect #1 laying in a stream of water in the gutter under a pick up truck. The suspect was not looking back and forth but straight ahead. I yelled to the subject to freeze. The subject turned his head to look behind him at me. I believe that he saw that I had my service revolver directed at him; he disregarded my order to freeze, and made a very dangerous move by moving his right hand into his front waistband.

The next encounter was when I was alongside and to the rear of the suspect. I told him again to freeze and not to move his hand from his waistband. He disregarded that order also. When he withdrew his hand he threw an object into the water. The object was a wallet. I then held the suspect by the right foot, I told the suspect to roll out from under the truck. He complied after a brief hesitation. I noticed the subject had no footwear except for white socks. Subject had no shirt either.

I contacted the suspect on the front lawn of the house adjacent to the pick up. Subject and I recognized each other. I had arrested this subject in the recent past for disorderly conduct at the Club Casino. At this time, the subject was in handcuffs. Subject was smirking/smiling very noticeably as Officer Schauer was walking the suspect off of the front lawn. The suspect looked at me and said something to the effect of "You ain't got nothin on me!". By the way the suspect was talking, standing, and walking, I saw no evidence of any intoxication of any type. The suspect snapped his remarks to me rather than yelled.

The next encounter with the suspect was at the booking desk. Officer Schauer was processing his paper work.

When the suspect saw me he greeted me calling me Mr. Mylett. Suspect did not seem very upset at all. He asked me if, when he got out of jail that night, if he would be allowed in the Casino Bar. I advised him no that he was barred from the bar. The suspect was laughing/chuckling as I answered the suspect. The suspect said quite vengefully to me something to the effect that he would beat this one just like the first one, and that he (the suspect) would be looking for me on the streets. The suspect seemed much more intent and concerned about revenge for being captured than he was about facing a charge of

aggravated robbery or any higher charge.

The suspect, as noted before, was known to me by his recklessness at the Club Casino 1001 S. Port. Approximately 3-4 weeks ago, the suspect entered the Casino and was very open about letting people know he had recently been released from the state penitentiary. At one point, suspect told my partner that he, the suspect, was in the pen when Sgt. Enrique Garcia got shot, but that he, the suspect, thought Garcia should have died. He used some obscene language in the course of saying this (I.E. mother fucker or son of a bitch to take the place of peoples names), in every encounter I had with the suspect before the arrest 2-4-83, I observed him to be a intimidating, disrespectful, unstable person. I observed him to intimidate those smaller or weaker than him but show a forced respect to those he had some fear of. Quite a few people, regulars at the Casino, noted the subject as being stupid and/or crazy.
