These rights were read to me before I made this statement. I understand my rights give them up before and during the making of this statement. No one has threatened forced me, or promised me anything to make me give up my rights and make this statement. This is my statement:

My name is Pedro Olivarez. I am 23 years old. I live at 1314 Whitaker. My phone number is 991-1784. I am not working at this time. I am giving this statement to Sgt. Smith of my free will and Sgt. Smith has not threaten me or promised me anything to give this statement. On November the 18th, 1979 I went to the Casino Club on Port Ave. While I was there I met a friend who I have known for two years. His name is Jesse Garza who lives on Dunbar St., it was around 11:00 p.m. We danced till the club closed then we went outside and I asked Jesse if I could spend the night at his house. He said O K. While we were outside a girl who I have known for about two years drove up in a dark brown and light brown van. Her name is Dalia Saucedo. and Jesse went and talked to her. Then he came back and Dalia left. Jesse told me that Dalia was coming back, but I told him not to count on it. But about thirty minutes later Dalia came back, and me, Jesse Garza, and Elias Garcia got into her van. Inside the van was some other people, a girl named Margie, a girl who I seen but don't know her name, but a little fat, and a guy with a full mustache. We drove out of town, to Kingsville and dropped this guy off. Then we came back to Corpus. Then we just cruised around town. We were smoking joints, we smoked three (3) joints. Then we went to a Seven Eleven Store and got ten dollars (\$10) worth of gas. And I got out of the van and Dalia gave me twenty dollars (\$20) to get gas. And Jesse went with me. Then we paid the lady and left, it was about 4:30 a.m. Then we went to Cole Park on Ocean Drive. We got a flat tire on the back right tire. Me and Elias got out and changed the tire. Then we went to the Ferry in Port Aransas and went across, and then back to Corpus. We stopped at a Seven Eleven Store to get some colling paper. And I saw a friend, but don't remember his name, he gave us some colling paper. Then I layed down in the back of the van and went to sleep. Then I woke up and we were all going to Margie's house. She lives on Staples St. near Baldwin. We dropped Margie and her friend and we left and just cruised around till about 7:00 a.m., this was Monday morning the 19th of November 1979. We then went to Jesse's house and I asked Jesse for a shirt to wear. Jesse gave me a light brown shirt to wear. Then we got back into the van and left. We then went to an apartment in the downtown area and Dalia got out of the van and went to the door. Two guys came out and got into the van with us all. One's name was Tony and the other guy's name was Johnny. Dalia said we were going to Kingsville to look for Johnny's girl-friend.

This was around 9:00 a.m., but first we stopped at some guy's house and Johnny went in and brought a lid of grass and then we left, going to Kingsville. On the way between Corpus and Driscoll, Texas, we had a flat and did not have a spare. So Jesse drove on the side of the road till we got to a gas station in Driscoll. Jesse had been driving all day. Dalia bought a tire that cost her around thirty nine dollars (\$39). Then we went on to Kingsville to a house. Nobody was at home so we left. We then came back to Corpus, to Johnny's house and we were there for about ten minutes. Johnny came back and we left and went to a girl's house, I think they called her Abbey, Dalia said she wanted to take a bath. Dalia got out of the van and went into the house and then Johnny got out and went into the house. Later Dalia came back and we were all just talking in the van, when Jesse told Dalia he would like to go home and Dalia said O K. Dalia called Johnny who was still in the house and Johnny came out with a girl and they both got in the van. Dalia told Johnny to drive, so we just cruised around for awhile. Then we went to Jesse's house on Dunbar St., it was around 4:00 p.m. Myself, Jesse and Elias got out and then Jesse was standing by the van talking with Dalia. Then Dalia left and Jesse told me that Dalia was going to pick us up at 10:00 p.m. tonight. Jesse, myself, and Elias went into the house and we went to sleep. I got up around 6:00 p.m. and so did Elias. A guy by the name of Roger came to the house, he lives there with his brother Marty. Roger asked if we wanted something to drink and I said yes. We walked to the store and got some cokes and came back. Then Roger said he was going to his girlfriend's house and he left, this was around 7:15 p.m., Monday night. Then around 8:00 p.m. Elias said he was going home and he left. I was watching the football game and the phone rang, it was Roger and he asked me if the girl in the van had come back yet, I told him she hadn't come back yet. I had told Roger earlier about Dalia and that she was coming back around 10:00 p.m. tonight, and he wanted to go with us. I told Roger I don't care. Then he said he would see us about 10:00 p.m. and hung up. Then around 9:00 p.m. a guy named Marty who is Roger's brother and who Jesse lives with came home. Me and Marty were watching the football game.

While me and Marty were watching the game Dalia came in her van and I woke up Jesse. Jesse and me went outside to the van and I looked inside the van and saw two guys. I asked her who the guys were and she said Johnny and Tony. Then I turned around and went back inside the house. Jesse stayed outside talking to Dalia for about 20 minutes. Then he came inside the house. Jesse told me that Dalia was coming back Tuesday morning for us. Then we finished watching the football game and Roger came back. Then we all went to the Circle K at Baldwin and Greenwood and got cokes and ice cream. On the way back a police car with two policemen in it stopped and checked us out. Then we got back to Jesse's house and ate ice cream and drank cokes. Roger went and layed down on the couch and I also layed down on the couch and Marty and Jesse were playing around like they were boxing. Marty went back to a bedroom, about 1:00 a.m., November 20, 1979. Shortly after that Dalia came back in her van and pulled up into the driveway. Dalia asked Jesse if he would like to go cruising around, Jesse said yes. I asked Jesse if I could go and Jesse said yes. We drove around for awhile around 1:30 a.m. we stopped at a Seven Eleven Store. Dalia and myself, went into the store. A lady was behind the counter. Dalia went over and got some cokes, bean dip, and Fritos. Then I told Dalia to hurry up. I went back to the van as Dalia was paying for the food and cokes. As I got close to the van Jesse was standing beside the van on the side of the store taking a pee. We all got back into the van and left. Jesse was driving, Dalia was sitting up front, and I was sitting in a chair behind the driver and Dalia's little baby girl was laying on the couch at the back of the van. Dalia's baby girl was with her when she picked us up at the house. We just drove around eating the bean dip, Fritos, and drinking the cokes. After we finished eating and drinking I asked Jesse, where we were going and he said not to worry about it. I went back to the couch near where the baby was asleep. Jesse then turned off some street onto a rough road and we parked. Jesse started kissing Dalia and trying to rub Dalia's tits.

Dalia kept pushing his hands away. I got up and opened the side door of the van and got out. We were parked next to a fence and a lot of bushes. I then closed the door and was standing by the van when Jesse called me. I opened the side door, Jesse and Dalia were right in the middle of the van. Then Jesse told me lets rape her. I was still outside the van. Jesse told Dalia, "I am going to rape you and if you don't I'm going to beat the hell out of you". Then Jesse started taking off her pants, but Dalia held her hand on the top of them. Jesse then hit her in the face knocking her down. Then Jesse pulled Dalia's pants off and panties. Her pants she had on were blue jeans. Then Jesse pulled down his pants and started fucking her. Dalia started screaming, and yelled, "Pete help me, his hitting me". Then Jesse went wild. He started hitting her all over, in the nose and all over her body. He just kept hitting her in the stomach till she stopped yelling. Then he got her blue jeans and wrapped the legs of the jeans around her neck and started choking her. I then turned around and left, because I didn't want to see what Jesse was doing to Dalia. I closed the van door. I waited about thirty minutes. While outside I saw the van rocking side to side as I opened the door I saw Jesse kneeling over Dalia. Dalia was laying on her back naked. Jesse then turned Dalia over and Dalia was laying face down. Jesse got an old rusty kitchen knife that was laying on the bar table in the van. Jesse then went back to where Dalia was lying and bent down and took the knife by the point and made a big "X" on her back. I told Jesse "lets go", Jesse said "Pete don't tell anybody I killed her, if you do I will come and shoot you". I looked at the baby and she was still asleep on the couch. Jesse got out of the van and I closed the door and left. We walked out from behind the van and across some railroad tracks up to the freeway and I started thumbing a ride on top of a freeway. About five to ten minutes passed when a white guy stopped. He was driving a white old Mustang and gave me and Jesse a ride to Jesse's house. Then we went to sleep. This statement I have just given Sgt. Smith is true and correct to best of my knowledge and Sgt. Smith did not promise me anything or threaten me to make this statement. And Sgt. Smith asked me if I would like a lawyer before I signed this statement and would I like to make a call to anybody and I told Sgt. Smith I did not want a lawyer or to make a phone call.
