TEMPORARY ORDERS

On the 17th day of November, 1983, came on to be heard the application of Petitioner, ROSA ANZALDUA HERNANDEZ for temporary orders.

Petitioner, ROSA ANZALDUA HERNANDEZ, appeared with attorney, JOSE LONGORIA and announced ready.

Respondent, CARLOS HERNANDEZ appeared without attorney, and announced ready.

The Court, having considered the pleadings and heard the evidence and argument of counsel, finds that all necessary prerequisites of the law have been legally satisfied and that this Court has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter of this cause.

The Court finds that the following orders for the safety and welfare of the Petitioner are in the best interest of the Petitioner:

IT IS ORDERED that Petitioner have the exclusive use of the residence located at 107 Sam Rankin, Corpus Christi, Texas; and exclusive use of the household furniture and furnishings.


IT IS ORDERED that the Respondent return to Petitioner immediately the 1975 Two door Mercury automobile with Serial No. 5H07H510875 with Texas License No. FKQ445. ~~In the event the Respondent is in the Nueces County Jail, the family of Respondent is ordered to return said automobile to Petitioner.~~

IT IS ORDERED that Respondent ~~and his family~~<sup>is</sup> immediately restrained from:

1. Harming, destroying, or wasting any property belonging to Petitioner or to Respondent.
2. Hiding or concealing any property belonging to Petitioner and/or to Respondent.
3. Communicating with Petitioner by writing, by telephone, by oral conversation, in person, or in any other manner.
4. Doing any act calculated to embarrass, harass, molest, injure or humiliate Petitioner.
5. Hurting, harming, or in any manner causing physical injury to Petitioner's person.
6. Interfering in any way with Petitioner's possession of the 1975 Mercury automobile.
7. Interfering in any way with Petitioner's exclusive use of the residence at 107 Sam Rankin, Corpus Christi, Texas.

All said temporary orders shall continue in force during the pendency of this suit or until further order of this Court.
