

## INVESTIGATION MEMORANDUM

On the above date I contacted **ANDRES YBANEZ (26 years old)**, at the Estelle Unit in Huntsville, Texas. I identified myself, stated who I represented and the purpose of my visit to which he understood.

Andres, unlike his older brother Johnny, did not “hang-out” with Carlos Hernandez and therefore did not have as many details about Mr. Hernandez’ character. He did provide me with the following information.

- According to Andres, Carlos Hernandez was good to him and his brother when he baby-sat for them. His dislike for him came when he stabbed his mother—he was present. Andres stated, “I think Carlos had a crush on my mom and he was real drunk that night. I thought he had pushed my mom at first. I didn’t realize until later that he had stabbed her. When he was on top of her I got a stick and hit him with it. He then just walked away.” It’s Andres’ understanding that Carlos was arrested at a PMI (convenience store) store.

- Andres was aware that Carlos Hernandez always carried a knife with him. He stated, “I do recall him threatening my stepfather, Gilbert Limon, with a knife but I don’t remember all the details.”

- Carlos Hernandez never talked to Andres about any killings. He stated, "I was too young."
- Gilbert Limon is the father of his younger brother "Jess" and his sister "Dina".
